

PRIVACY POLICY MODEL FOR MOBILE APPLICATIONS

This privacy policy governs use of the software applications (“Applications”) for mobile devices that are created by the National Center for Telehealth & Technology.

What information do the Applications obtain and how is it used?

Types of Data collected

Among the types of Personal Data that these Applications collect, by itself or through third parties, there are: Usage Data, heart rate and other vital data, movement activity, Reminders permission, Calendar permission, Contacts permission, Camera permission, Precise location permission (non-continuous), Approximate location permission (non-continuous), Microphone permission, Phone permission, Storage permission and Bluetooth sharing permission.

Other Personal Data collected may be described in other sections of this privacy policy or by dedicated explanation text contextually with the Data collection.

The Personal Data may be freely provided by the User, or collected automatically when using these Applications.

None of the Personal Data collected by these Applications is stored, centralized, or aggregated in any way by the National Center for Telehealth & Technology. We do not have access to your Personal Data and it does not leave the specific mobile device on which it was gathered.

Failure to provide certain Personal Data may make it impossible for this Application to provide its services.

Users are responsible for any Personal Data of third parties obtained, published or shared through these Applications and confirm that they have the third party's consent to provide the Data to the Owner.

User Provided Information

Depending on the User's specific device, these Applications may request certain permissions that allow them to access the User's device Data as described below.

By default, these permissions must be granted by the User before the respective information can be accessed. Once the permission has been given, it can be revoked by the User at any time. In order to revoke these permissions, Users may refer to the device settings or contact the Owner for support at the contact details provided in the present document.

Again, the National Center for Telehealth & Technology does not have access to your Personal Data as used by these Applications. We have no way to collect, aggregate or store this



information and all the Personal Data collected or produced by these Applications remain on the user's device.

The exact procedure for controlling app permissions may be dependent on the User's device and software.

Please note that the revoking of such permissions might impact the proper functioning of this Application.

If User grants any of the permissions listed below, the respective Personal Data may be processed (i.e accessed to, modified or removed) by these Applications.

Approximate location permission (non-continuous)

Used for accessing the User's approximate device location. These Applications may collect and use User location Data in order to provide location-based services.

The geographic location of the User is determined in a manner that isn't continuous. This means that it is impossible for these Applications to derive the approximate position of the User on a continuous basis.

Bluetooth sharing permission

Used for accessing Bluetooth related functions such as scanning for devices, connecting with devices, and allowing data transfer between devices.

Calendar permission

Used for accessing the calendar on the User's device, including the reading, adding and removing of entries.

Camera permission

Used for accessing the camera or capturing images and video from the device.

Contacts permission

Used for accessing contacts and profiles on the User's device, including the changing of entries.

Microphone permission

Used for accessing and recording microphone audio from the User's device.

Phone permission

Used for accessing a host of typical features associated with telephony. This enables, for instance, read-only access to the "phone state", which means it enables access to the phone number of the device, current mobile network information, or the status of any ongoing calls.



Precise location permission (non-continuous)

Used for accessing the User's precise device location. These Applications may collect, use, and share User location Data in order to provide location-based services.

The geographic location of the User is determined in a manner that isn't continuous. This means that it is impossible for this Application to derive the exact position of the User on a continuous basis.

Reminders permission

Used for accessing the Reminders app on the User's device, including the reading, adding and removing of entries.

Storage permission

Used for accessing shared external storage, including the reading and adding of any items.

What are my opt-out rights?

You can stop all use of information by these Applications easily by uninstalling the Application. You may use the standard uninstall processes as may be available as part of your mobile device or via the mobile application marketplace or network.

Children

We do not use these Applications to knowingly solicit data from or market to children under the age of 13. In any case, the application does not collect any personally identifiable information.

Security

We are concerned about safeguarding the confidentiality of your information. We provide physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards to help you protect information generated by our applications. Please be aware that, although we endeavor to provide reasonable security for information we process and maintain, no security system can prevent all potential security breaches.

Changes

This Privacy Policy may be updated from time to time for any reason. We will notify you of any changes to our Privacy Policy by posting the new Privacy Policy here. You are advised to consult this Privacy Policy regularly for any changes, as continued use is deemed approval of all changes.
